#### **Erasmus+ External Dimension**

- Budget for the external dimension of Erasmus+:
   EUR 1.74 billion for 2014-2020. Support higher education in over 100 countries financed by external aid financial instruments:
- Development Cooperation Instrument
- European Development Fund
- European Neighbourhood Instrument
- Instrument for Pre-Accession Assistance
- Partnership Instrument



#### **Policy framework**

- The 2030 Agenda: EU committed to SDG 4 which aims at ensuring 'inclusive and equitable quality education and promote life-learning opportunities for all'
- The European Consensus on Development (March 2017): outlines EU support to education, main concern and development priority 'leaving no one behind '
- The Global Strategy for the EU's Foreign and Security Policy commits to deepen support to education at all levels (educational exchanges = fostered resilience, pluralism)
- Eu-Africa Alliance, Joint Communication "Connecting Europe and Asia", Joint Communication "European Union, Latin America and the Caribbean: joining forces for a common future", etc...



### **Principles and Objectives**

 Erasmus + actions implemented within the framework of external policies of the EU and should thus contribute to their development objectives.

#### • Why CHBE matter?

- Modernisation / accessibility, relevance and internationalisation of higher education of HEIs and Higher Education Systems.
- > Regional cooperation and integration.
- Improve the level of competences, skills and employability potential in partner country HEIs.
- Promote people-to-people contacts, intercultural awareness and understanding.

# Development cooperation priorities

- More inclusive: better representation of disadvantaged individuals (with a particular focus on gender balance) and smaller-size institutions
- Increase engagement with local authorities and higher education sector decision makers (where possible)
- Strengthen links with Delegations -> better synergies and complementarities



#### **Development cooperation priorities**

- Strengthening employability: cooperation among academic, research and business world, vocational approach encouraged , i.e. improving skills and competences to respond to labour market needs
- > Sustainability: leave a legacy behind!
- > Lessons learned and recommendations

- New Instrument: New Financing Instrument: The Neighborhood, Development and International Cooperation Instrument
- New priorities at macro level (digitalisation, green deal, growth and jobs, migration, peace and security)
