Agenda of the meeting:

1. Information about the project progress
  - RTU will pay for 3 e-book issue in the RTU Publishing House.
  
2. A feedback from the Agency EACEA
  - EACEA promises to accept a Midterm report by the end of August. Probably the 2<sup>nd</sup> payment might be in September.
  - Due to summer vacation EACEA postponed answer to the request of the consortium about continuation of the project.
  
3. To discuss activities that should help to continue CybPhys.
  - Information from RTU.
  - CPNU prepares TS for SMSE.
  
4. WP2: progress of e-books. Is it possible to complete the books 4, 5 and 9, developed by Belarusian colleagues?
  - The work on e-books 4, 5, and 9 has been suspended, because Belarussian partners do not have financing (*High-Performance Scientific Computing and Data Analysis, Computer modelling of physical processes and phenomena, Modern Mathematical Physics: Fundamentals and Application*).
  - A.Zabašta will discuss with the leaders of the books about a minimum job to be done that these books could be used by teachers and students.
  
5. English course in Brugge.
  - KU Leuven is ready for the courses.
  - The number of Ukrainian teachers is forecasted 10-12.
  - The trainees may buy tickets and book hotels!
  - KU Leuven will give possibility to participate on line for Belarusian and Ukrainian trainees.
