The entire European Union has approximately 447 million inhabitants.

There are 24 official languages.



### The European Union

In the European Union, 19 member states use **the euro** as

their currency.





**Belgium** is a member of the European Union and uses **the euro** as its currency.








Belgium is a rather small country in the centre of Europe.



At present, we are located in the city of **Bruges**.

Bruges (Brugge) is a historical and very touristic city.

The historic centre of Bruges has been a **UNESCO World Heritage** since 2000.






#### Bruges is a city with a large history:

- People were already living here around 200 AD. (anno domini)
- Especially from the 9<sup>th</sup> to the 12<sup>th</sup> century, the city was growing rapidly. Till around 1500 AD, the city of Bruges was an important **harbour**.
  - There was a lot of trade. The city was rich, architecture and culture were flourishing.
- After the Middle Ages, the importance of Bruges declined: economical and political crises.





A very famous **map of Bruges** made by Marcus Gerards (1562).

The street pattern still exists, a lot of buildings still exist.

#### Bruges has a large number of historical buildings.

The KULeuven was founded in 1425 and it is the oldest and largest university in Belgium.

#### The KULeuven is the largest univerity of Belgium:

- 60 057 students
- 12 421 international students

In academic year 2020-2021:

90 students from Ukraine

7 students from Belarus







The KULeuven has 16 faculties.

The faculty has campuses in 7 different cities in Flanders.

Today, we are at the **KULeuven Campus Bruges**.



At Campus Bruges, KULeuven has **615 students** (2020-2021).

We are a rather **small campus** in a much larger university.



At **KULeuven Campus Bruges**, we do not only teach. There are four **research groups**.
