Project monitoring

- Coordinator's efforts to keep the project alive despite the circumstances
- Termination of 4 partners
- Difficulties to readjust the budget
- Adjustment of partnership (5 Ben and 2 affiliated entities) and extension of the project implementation
- Mitigation measure to be put in place in the coming months
- Risks assessment increased

Issues to tackle

- Equipment should be instrumental to the objectives of the project and should therefore be purchased at the beginning of the project implementation.
- The extension is given by exception on justified cases.
- Purchasing equipment over €25.000 the beneficiaries must obtain competitive tenders from at least three suppliers and retain the one offering the best value for money, observing the principles of transparency and equal treatment of the potential contractors and taking care to avoid conflicts of interests.
