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Education institutions operational... Students recruited and started education

- Education process restarted on 14 March in distance/blended learning formats!!!
- ✓ 24 regions of Ukraine are providing school, VET&higher education in distance format.
- ✓ 12 in blended format online/offline: strong solidarity among institutions!!!
- Where necessary, educational institutions were relocated to the territory controlled by Ukraine's Authorities and continue educational process during war in online/blended formats based on the situation and possibility to ensure shelters and other safety measures.
- 30 higher education institutions, 65 HEI affiliated units and 44 professional pre-higher educational institutions were displaced.
- Professional pre-higher and higher education institutions applications submitted up to 1,149 mln.:
- 636,000 for Bachelor and medical Master programs, 202,5000 for Master programs
- 205,600 for professional bachelor programs, 1,700 for junior bachelor programs.

Over 67 000 students were recommended for budget funding Largest number of applications submitted to the pre-higher and HEIs in Kyiv, Lviv, Dnipropetrovsk, and Kharkiv regions.





RUSSIA'S WAR ON UKRAINE: UKRAINIAN STUDENTS IN THE EU



Russia's invasion of Ukraine on 24 February 2022 has caused vast displacement of people within the country as well as across the EU borders. While the annexation of Crimea had a negative impact on the country's education system, recent events have added additional strain.

Outbound student mobility was already substantial in recent years, but it has accelerated even further since the Crimean conflict began. After doubling from some 25 000 to nearly 50 000 between 2007 and 2014, the number of Ukrainian students abroad has since skyrocketed by another 54 % to around 78 000 in 2019.

Approximately 49 000 Ukrainian students were attending various higher education institutions across the EU in 2019. This means that approximately 60 % of the 78 000 Ukrainians studying abroad worldwide in 2019 chose to study in the EU. The countries welcoming the highest numbers of students are Poland, Germany, Czechia and Slovakia.

Some 480 Ukrainian students are currently engaged in Erasmus+ activities via the programme's international strand. In the 2015-2019 programming period, Ukraine received 40 % of the available funding in the Eastern Partnership region, and over 9 000 Ukrainian students and staff participated in more than 1 300 Erasmus projects.

Following the Russian invasion of Ukraine, Commissioner Mariya Gabriel announced, on 2 March 2022, that the Commission would grant maximum flexibility in the implementation of Erasmus+ projects involving Ukrainian





Challenges for Mobility Projects

- Institutional regulation for Mobility does not reflect the war time!
- Not ready/able to apply flexibility
- Recognition by the EU universities of prior study or belonging to the university without the documents which were lost/destroyed during war/ recognition for mobility periods
- Study or Traineeship for 1st year students, longer period of semester 4th year students
- Teaching, Training, Job shadowing for staff
- Passport, visa and crossing the border
- Crossing the border for male 18-60 years old
- Temporary protection status vs students visa etc.
 Inter-Institutional Agreement is a must to have for mobility recognition!!!

Erasmus+ Enriching lives, opening minds Challenge for male students and staff participation in Erasmus+ abroad: to provide transparent and comprehensive communication to the international partners about the male students possibility to study/traineeship abroad

The male students and staff 18-60 years old are **not allowed to cross the border** with some exceptions!!!

- University students are exempt from mobilization for the study period!!!
- However it does not provide automatic permission for the border crossing!!!
- The final decision is taken by the Border Control Officer based on the provided documents.

The documents package include:

- Enrolment/Admission/ Acceptance for Students; Invitation letter for staff; Students card or students visa Additionally: Mobility Agreement, Inter-Institutional Agreements, Nomination letter, Student's Card, Health Insurance Certificate, UA University support letter and MoESU letter etc, depending on the type of mobility.
- Certificate from the Military Service Center of Ukraine is obligatory document in the package of documents for the crossing the border
